Second, is there any ARES leadership on frequency. This would include Emergency Coordinators, Assistant Emergency Coordinators, District Emergency Coordinators and Assistant District Emergency Coordinators. If so, come now.

I will now pause for any formal written traffic for the net. Stations with formal written traffic, please call (your call) , Net Control.

I will now accept check-ins from members of Marathon County. Marathon County amateur radio operators please call now, (your call).
